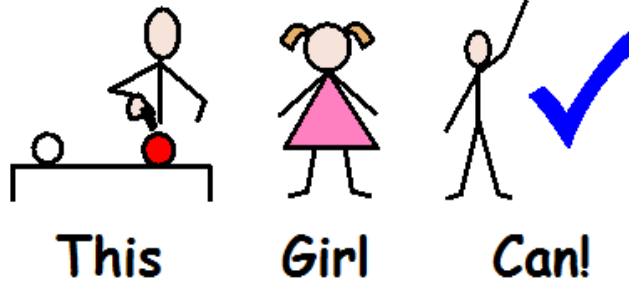

We look forward to seeing you there!



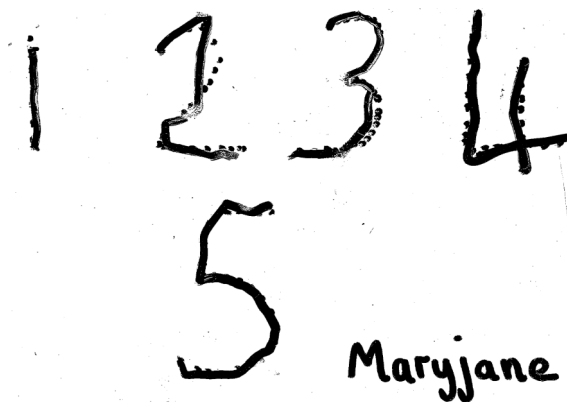
