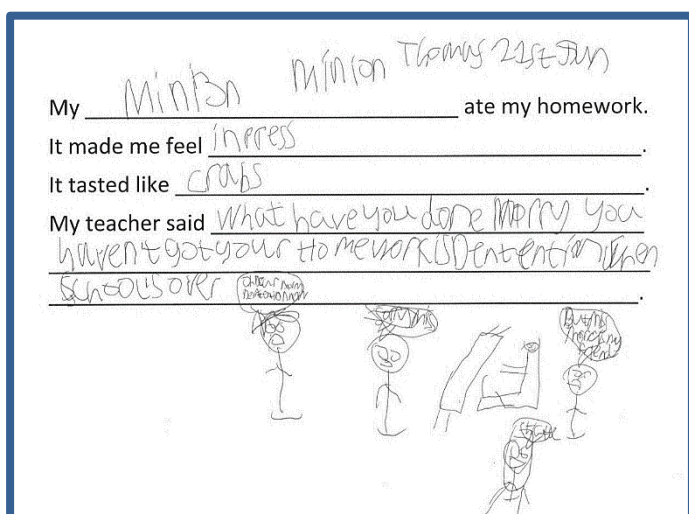

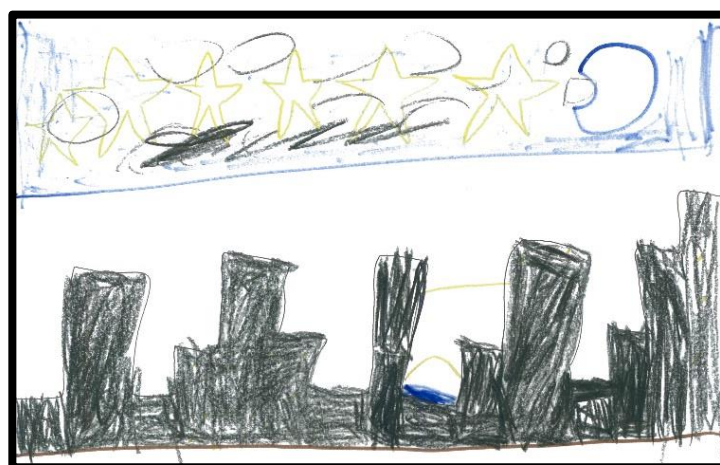
## CELEBRATING OUR ACHIEVEMENTS
