Post 16 Leavers Celebration Assembly - 10am Thursday 20th July: All Post 16 parents are welcome.

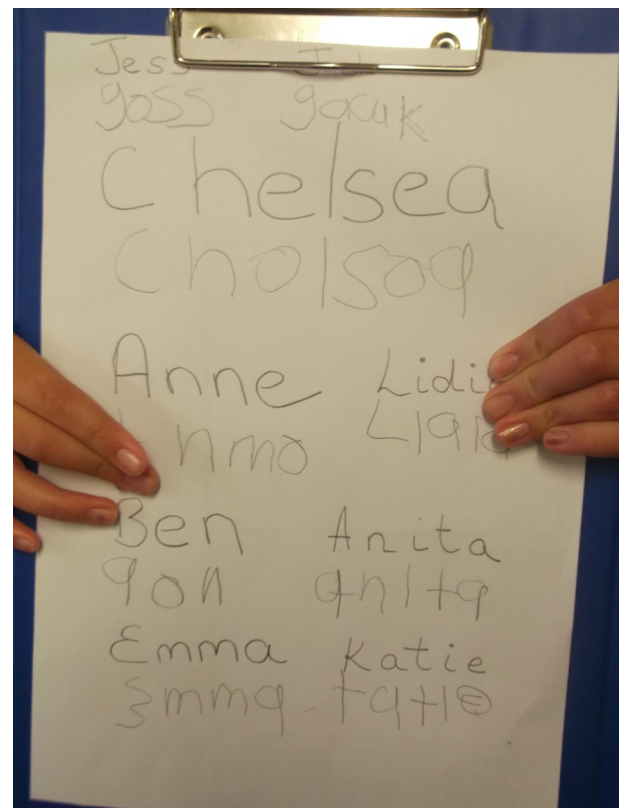
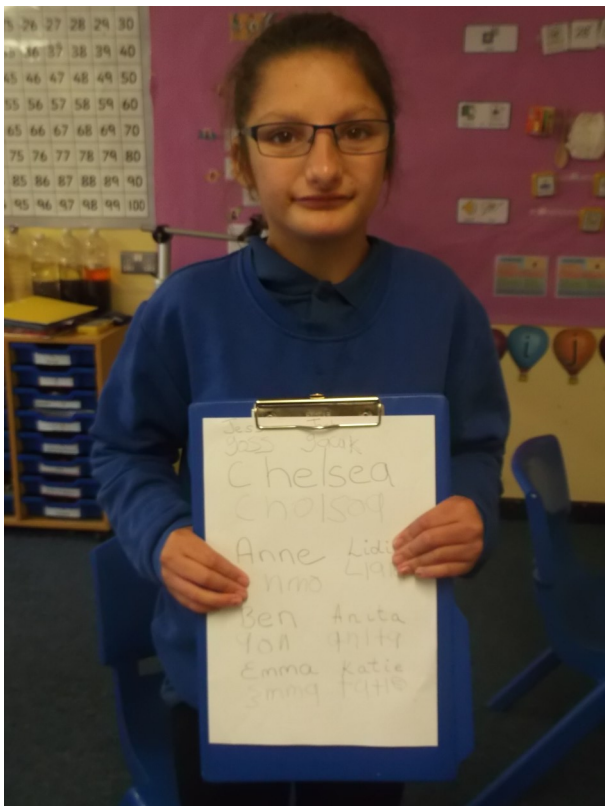
