UPDATE ON SPEECH AND LANGUAGE THERAPY PROVISION

We have been informed by Jenny Moultrie, Speech and Language Therapy Lead, and Liz Parker, Speech and Language Therapist of the following input for pupils at Warmley Park:

- For term 1 (until October half term) Liz will be coming into school for 2 days to advise staff through a consultancy clinic on Speech and Therapy needs. There will be a half a day per fortnight of Speech and Language Therapy Assistant provision to offer communication groups to pupils.
- From term 2 (after October half term) Warmley Park will have a day per week of Speech and Language Therapy input from the NHS with a new therapist who will be supported by Liz.


You should have received the Annual Review date for your child at the end of the last term. If you have not received the letter yet notifying you of the planned date, can you please contact Scott.
