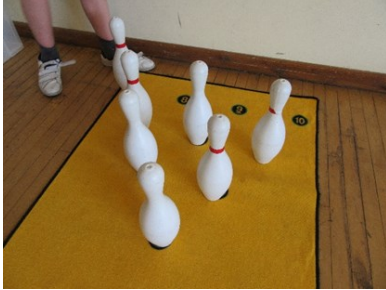

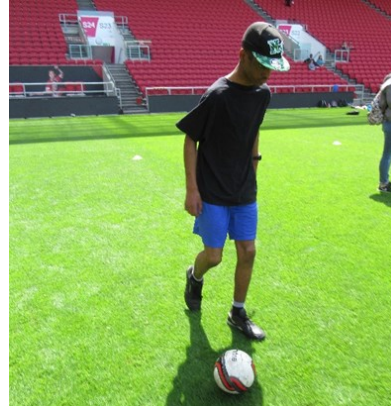
Inter Class Target Games competition 2017
