CELEBRATING OUR ACHIEVEMENTS



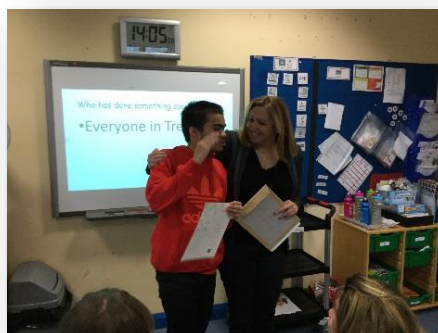
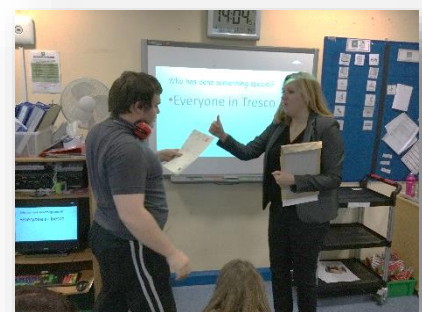
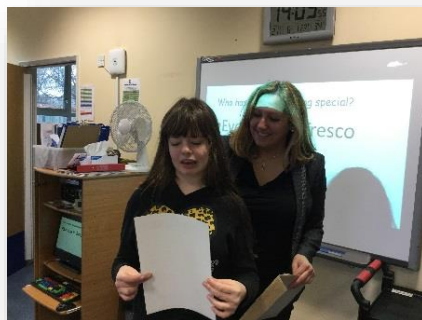
Last week was a fantastic first week back, everyone settled in well and worked really hard! Well done to Maryjane for being awarded a Superstar Award.
