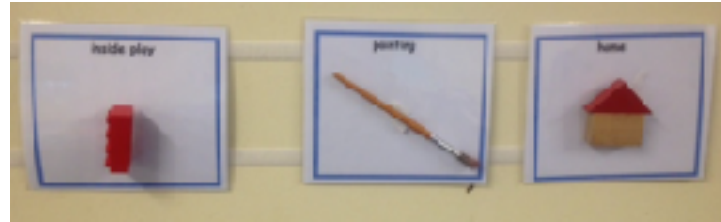


Objects of reference

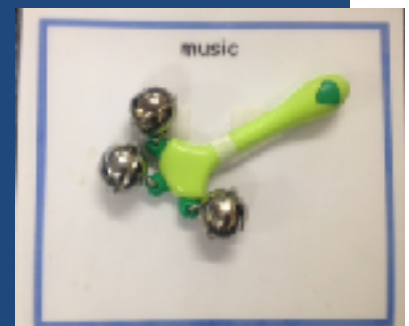


WHAT ARE OBJECTS OF REFERENCE?

- Objects of reference are a simple method of communicating, but they can be used at a number of different levels, supporting other forms of communication
- Objects of reference is a term that describes the use of objects as a means of communication
- The objects, just like words, signs and symbols, can be made to represent those things about which we all communicate e.g. needs, choice making, routine of the day

WHY DO WE USE OBJECTS OF REFERENCE?

- Objects of reference give our children information about their daily school routine, what is going to happen next, they help them to make choices
- Objects of reference are used throughout the school day to provide children with the information they need to support them
