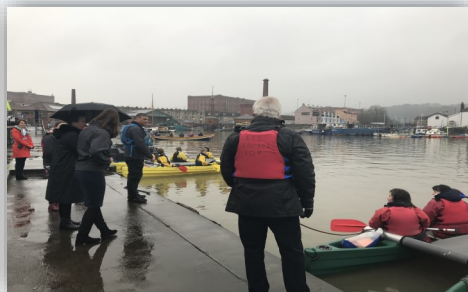

A special thank you to Emma and her members at Hanham Weightwatchers group who donated £55 to the school from the proceeds of their Christmas raffle.



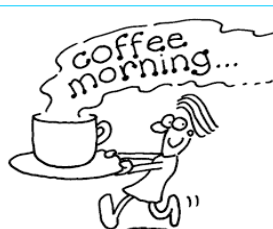
Tom Loveday's 0-25 Friday Morning Surgery is back!
