The following information has come from the European Medicines Agency and the UK Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency (MHRA):

- There have been reports of a product quality defect related to **BUCCOLAM** pre-filled plastic syringes.
- In a very small number of cases, the translucent tip-cap has remained on the syringe tip when the red cap is pulled off.
- If the translucent tip-cap remains on the syringe tip, it will prevent the administration of **BUCCOLAM**.
- If this occurs, the translucent tip-cap needs to be removed manually.
