SCHOOL MEALS

Universal free school meals finish for pupils at the end of Key Stage 1 (year 2). Once your child starts Key Stage 2 (year 3), school meals will need to be paid for unless your child has an entitlement to free school meals. Alternatively, a packed lunch can be brought in from home, please remember that Warmley Park is a nut free school. If you think your child is eligible for free school meals, please contact the school office for further information.

SCHOOL MILK SERVICES

School Milk Services offer subsidised fresh milk daily, the scheme has been set up jointly by the Local Education Authority and School Milk Services Limited. Milk for schools is recommended by the Health & Education Department as it contains body building protein and calories for energy which is important whilst learning. On Thursday 19th April we will be holding our first ever Spring Show. The theme of our event is:

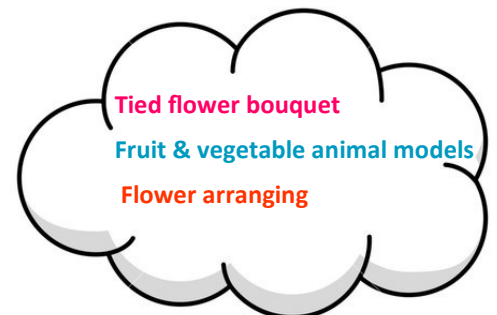
'Our Wonderful World'
