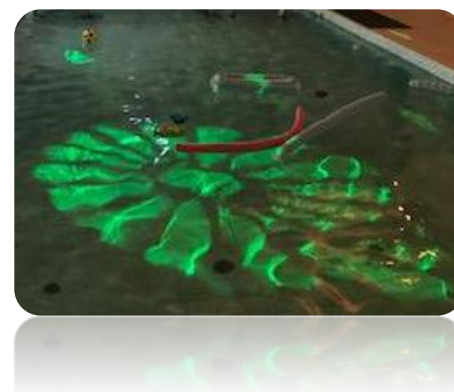
## News from Lisa
