Rockhopper Awards

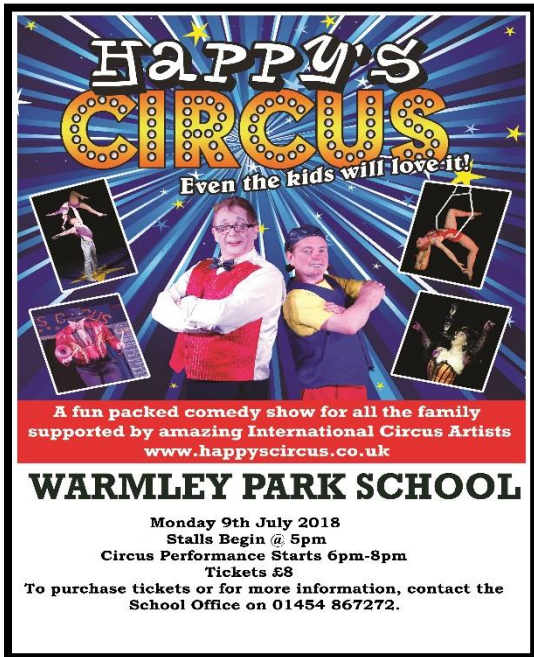
